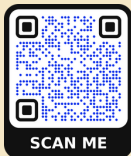
KATS Drone Pilot Certification Workshop

Strawberry Salsa

1 tablespoon olive oil	2 cups, coarsely chopped fresh strawberries
2 cups chopped cherry or grape	8 green onions, chopped
2 cups chopped tomato	1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup chopped fresh cilantro	vinegar or white balsamic vinegar

1. Whisk olive oil, vinegar, and salt in large bowl.

2. Add strawberries, green onions, tomatoes, and cilantro. Toss to coat.

3. Cover and chill for 1 hour.

4. Serve with tortilla or pita chips.
